

Rules & Regulations

1. 5 fish limit per boat – All 15" in length, measured with mouth closed on Golden Ruler.
2. Smallmouth, largemouth, and spotted bass only.
3. Short fish: If you bring a short fish to the scales you will lose that fish plus you will be given a one pound penalty.
4. Only artificial baits will be allowed.
5. No more than two contestants per boats
6. Live wells will be checked before tournament.
7. Contestants may fish anywhere accessible by boat, except within 50 yards of any other competitors' boat.
8. All angling must be conducted from the boat.
9. Contestants must leave and return to the official checkpoint by boat.
10. Contestants who are not at the official check in area at the appointed time will be penalized one pound per minute deducted from the total weight.
11. There will be an eight ounce penalty per dead fish.
12. Any contestant more than fifteen minutes late will be disqualified.
13. Tournament committee shall have the final say in the interpretation of the rules.
14. Winners will be subject to polygraph.
15. In the event of a tie, monies will be added together and divided equally among those who tie.
16. TWRA boating safety rules apply as for the safety regulations for the tournament.
17. Youth contestant must be 18 (senior) or younger.
18. **Early** entry fee is \$100 per boat. Sat. entry fee \$110. Optional big fish pot of \$10 with 60% largest & 40% second largest.
19. Blast off from Birdsong Resort & Marina, 255 Marina Road Camden, TN at 6:00 and weigh in at 2:00.
20. Tournament payback 75%.

Early Registration Procedures:

Participants will register in the CHS cafeteria. Once everyone has registered, the tournament committee will blind draw for blast off placement one at a time. (Approx. 6:45)

Anyone not able to attend early registration will be given blast off chip on a first come first serve basis on Saturday morning starting at 5:00. We will still accept registration applications on Saturday, May 15, until blast off, but Saturday registration fee is \$110.
